



2024 Spring Rifle Fun League at Tacoma Rifle & Revolver Club

(A two gun league, 22LR-Rimfire and Centerfire)

Dates:

- May 14th to June 25th, 2024. Tuesday evenings.
- There are 7 match days scheduled to shoot 6 scores for record.

Time:

- 3:00 pm, 4:00 pm & 5:00 pm relays.

Location:

- Tacoma Rifle and Revolver Club (TRRC), Main Range

League Fee:

- \$20.00 (\$18.16 + \$1.84 tax) Pay at the first league night, prior to shooting your first relay.

Course of Fire:

- Benchrest: 15 minutes for unlimited sighting shots on a sighter target and 10 shots for record. Competitors may place any sighting target on the blank 2'x2' target provided. Record targets: MR-31 and MR-52
- Standing: 10 shots in 10 minutes (no support). Record targets: SR-1 and SR
- Alternating weeks, we will shoot 22LR rifles at 100 yards, then centerfire rifles at 200 yards, starting with 100 yards on May 14th.
- On the 7th week, June 25th, targets will be available at both 100 yards and 200 yards, in order to allow competitors to make up scores at either distance. Also, on June 25th only, when all 6 scores for record have been shot, competitors may choose one of their previous scores to replace and shoot a relay to replace that score. That score will then **replace the previous score.**

Rules:

- 22LR rimfire rifles will be shot at 100yds, and centerfire rifles will be shot at 200 yards.
- Scoring will be done by competitors. If more than 10 shots are noted on the record target, score the low ten.
- Competitors may place "shoot-n-see" targets or light colored paper on the bullseye to aid in seeing shots through a spotting scope. These will be removed for scoring. Please bring your own.
- Only one round will be loaded in the gun at a time while shooting standing. Up to 5 rounds may be loaded when shooting from the bench.
- Shooting coats and gloves will be allowed. No slings.
- You can use a different rifle each relay, but the same rifle & scope must be used for both stages of a relay.
- Calibers allowed: Centerfire, 22 to 30 caliber (223, 222, 243, 270, 308, 30-06, 6mm, 7mm, for example, are OK.)
- No short barreled rifles. Barrels must be at least 16".
- No magnum cartridges will be allowed.
- No muzzle brakes or compensators will be allowed, due to noise considerations.

Squading:

- Advanced reservations recommended; specify relay when registering. Competitors will be assigned to relays on a first come-first serve basis. There are 12 spots available per relay.

Awards:

- Awards will be presented to the top competitors in each category.
