



2024 Advanced Pistol Marksmanship & Bullseye Shooting Clinic

Saturday, April 13, 2024, 12:00pm to 4:00pm

Clinic Summary: This class will provide pistol marksmanship training beyond that which is provided in an NRA Basic Pistol Course. It will introduce pistol shooters to the course of fire and rules for NRA precision pistol “bullseye” competition. It will also prepare participants for the TRRC spring pistol league, which is a developmental-fun pistol league. Classroom instruction will be followed by live-fire practice at an outdoor range.

Prerequisites: Participants should have completed an NRA Basic Pistol Course, or have equivalent experience shooting pistols. This is not a class for new pistol owners. For TRRC members, pistol qualification is required. The participant must bring a safe pistol and 60 rounds of ammunition. Any caliber is allowed; however, 22 caliber is preferred. No magnum loads are allowed. The minimum age is 16. Minors 16 to 18 years of age must be accompanied by a parent.

Date / Time: Saturday, April 13, 2024. Meet in the TRRC classroom 12:00pm.

Location: Tacoma Rifle and Revolver Club, 8503 Chambers Creek Road West, University Place, WA 98467. To enter the club, press the black button, located beside the card reader at the front gate.

Cost: \$5. Class size is limited to 22 participants.

Registration: *Advance registration is required.* E-mail your request to Duane Hatch at the email listed below. Please include following information: Name, address, phone number, shooting experience, and model & caliber of the pistol you plan to bring.

Rules: TRRC safety rules will govern. No live ammunition is allowed in the classroom.

Things to bring:

- Eye glasses. Bring all your glasses! Reading, computer, old (weaker) reading, distance.
- Pen and paper to take notes.
- Dress for the weather, as at least two hours will be spent at an outdoor range.
- Eye and Hearing Protection
- Any safe pistol (22 to 45 caliber) with 2 magazines for semi-automatic pistols. No magnums.
- 60 rounds of ammunition.
- Spotting scope or binoculars – recommended but not mandatory.
- Stapler (Light duty only, 1/4” staples) and masking tape (beige colored).

Food: Bring water and snacks as needed. Snacks and soda pop machine are available at the club.
